## Activities of The Science Forum since its inception in 2003 to 2016

'The Science Forum', B.H. College, Howly was formed on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2003 under the leadership of Dr. R. K. Das, Principal, B. H. College, Howly where Sadananda Nath, HoD, Zoology was selected as first Secretary of the forum.
