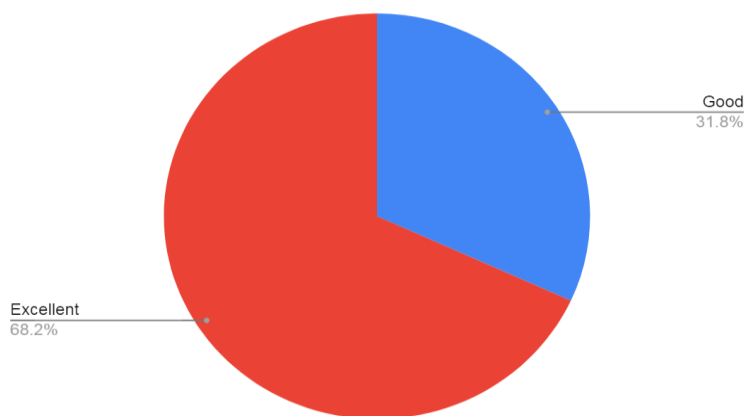

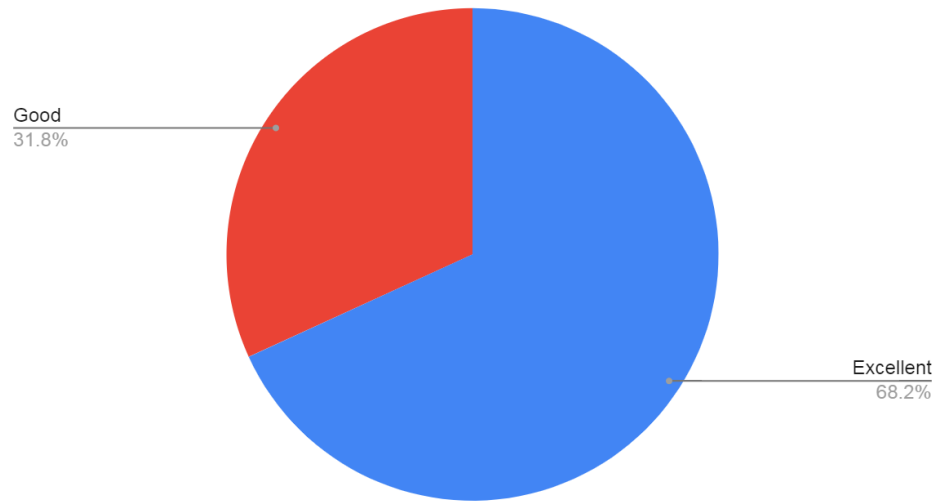

Summary of the event	<p>The IQAC, B.H.College,Howly has organised an invited talk on Research Ethics on 03/03/2023 at 1.30 PM in the seminar hall of the college. Dr. Jayanta Kr. Bora (Founding & Executive Director of VART Consulting Pvt. Ltd Delhi-NCR & Mumbai, India) was invited as the resource person for the said talk. In the inaugural session Dr Jayanta Bora was felicitated with a Phulom gamosha by Dr. Suruchi Singh, Assistant Professor of Zoology department and Dr Bagsmrita Bhagawati,Assistant Professor of Statistics department introduced the resource person to the audience.The program was started with the inaugural lecture by Dr. Bhushan Ch. Pathak, Principal, B.H.College, Howly. In his lecture he welcomed the resource person Dr. Bora and hoped that this topic of talk will be of immense help to the audience specially PG students who are new in the field of research. The inaugural lecture was followed by speech by Dr. Rabinjyoti Khataniar,Coordinator of IQAC, B.H. College, Howly. Dr Khataniar in his speech encouraged the audience to grab this opportunity to learn about different aspects of Research Ethics. He motivate them to take active part in the interaction session. He also hoped that this kind of program will boosts students to conduct research systematically. After this inaugural session Dr Bora started his informative piece of talk starting with what is ethics, different states of ethics. He discussed the three fundamental principle of research ethics namely justice, respect and</p>

	<p>beneficial. He talked about importance of research ethics in social science and discussed in detail about the difference between clinical and social science research. He talked about the 8 phases of social science research and 4 phases of clinical research. He mentioned about Institutional Review Board (IRB). He illustrated it by discussing about the research ethics of Demographic Health Survey (DHS) specially NFHS. He also mentioned about the child marriage issue that came to notice of the government by studying the report of NFHS5. He discussed elaborately publishing ethics and about the peril one has to face if one breaks the ethics. He defined key terminologies like plagiarism, types of plagiarism, data fabrication and falsification, conflict of interest, authorship disputes, duplicate publication etc. A few students namely Tapanjit Roy, Sagatika Pathak of Zoology department and Japhungshar Brahma of M.Com 4th semester also enthusiastically interacted with the resource person. After the programme, feedback were collected from the participants through google form.</p>
