

Feedback For the academic session:2023-2024

1. Feedback on College Environment by Students:

Responses on Feedback on college environment were collected on online mode. Total numbers of respondent participated in this survey are 544. Students from Odd semester Class of various departments took part in this survey.

a. Methods of analysis:

The feedback from the students was taken through questionnaire method and the students were asked to respond to the sets of questions as provided by the concerned cell. For proper analysis of the student's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondent favouring for "Very Good" and "Good" remark.

The details of analysis are given in table-16 showing the responses in figures against various quality remarks of the questions.

2. Feedback from Parents:

The feedback from parents was taken in online mode. Total 517 Parents participated in the parents’ satisfaction survey. The questions were framed to know the level of satisfaction of the parents on various aspects of college environment influencing their wards.

a. Methods of analysis:

The feedback from the parents was taken through questionnaire method and they were asked to respond to the sets of questions as provided by the concerned cell. For proper analysis of the parent's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondents favoring for “Strongly Agree” and “Agree” remark.

b. Results and Analysis:

The details of analysis are given in table-17 showing the responses in figures against various quality remarks of the questions. The analysis on the feedback of the parents reveal that majority of the respondents have favoured for “strongly agree and agree” remark against the questions of the feedback form. Hence, it can be concluded that the feedback of parents are satisfactory on the college as a whole.

Based on the feedback of the alumni the college authority has initiated a number of measures. To mention a few are:

5. Feedback from Teachers on curriculum:

Feedback from teachers on curriculum was taken to know the level of difficulty and challenges faced by the teachers in implementing the same in teaching learning practices.

a. Method of analysis:

For proper analysis of the teacher's response, a minimum standard against the response of each question has been framed by the Feedback cell, B. H. College which is called as "Minimum Standard of Response". Such, "Minimum Standard of Response", against each question is declared as positive and satisfactory response, when it is endorsed with minimum 50% of the respondent favouring for "Strongly Agree" and "Agree" remark. The details of analysis are given in table-20 showing the responses in figures against various quality remarks of the questions.
