



College administration is a cooperative effort of Principal, teaching, non-teaching staff and students with the cooperation and support of all stakeholders in pursuit of common objective.

The Governing Body, which consists of various stakeholders such as a representative of teachers, parents/guardians, a nominee from the university with the Principal as the secretary, is the apex decision making body which coordinates its decisions taken in meetings' resolutions with the Principal, who delegates the work to the appropriate cells/committees or designated authorities. Principal is the chairman of all committees and cells. These committees and cells as well as persons appointed at an individual capacity designated for any work, takes decisions and actions duly ratified by the Principal. Furthermore, these cells/committees come up with their own reports and suggestions which are communicated to the Governing Body for further actions through the Principal.
