ABOUT THE WORKSHOP:

By identifying essential knowledge and skills required for pursuing careers in biodiversity conservation, including the imperative of sustainable development and combating climate change, the workshop offers specialized instruction, breakout sessions, and brainstorming activities. Adopting an interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary approach, the workshop integrates natural and social sciences to tackle the multifaceted challenges of biodiversity conservation. Renowned expert Prof. Ramesh 'Zimbo' **Boonratana** will facilitate interactive sessions. imparting theoretical insights and practical experiences. Additionally, Dr. L.B. Singh, Assistant Professor in the Department of South East Asian Studies at Manipur University, will contribute expertise on selected topics, including tourism development and international trade augmentation, particularly relevant to the Act East Policy of India.

The two day workshop aims to provide:

- 1. A platform designed to connect participants with international transdisciplinary experts, facilitating the exchange of insights and the acquisition of practical competencies crucial for effective conservation practices and career development in biodiversity conservation.
- 2. Participants will engage in brainstorming sessions to explore ways of applying

- 3. Opportunities will be provided for participants to analyze case studies of biodiversity conservation projects and propose optimal solutions to address threats and impacts.
- 4. Networking opportunities will abound, allowing participants to connect with professionals, researchers, and peers, fostering collaboration and knowledge sharing.
- 5. Intensive sessions will focus on effective communication strategies, empowering participants to convey scientific findings to diverse audiences, including policymakers, communities, and the general public, and on understanding the UN-SDGs and GBIF for biodiversity conservation.

All the participants will receive a certificate of participation, recognising their commitment to enhancing competencies in biodiversity conservation.
