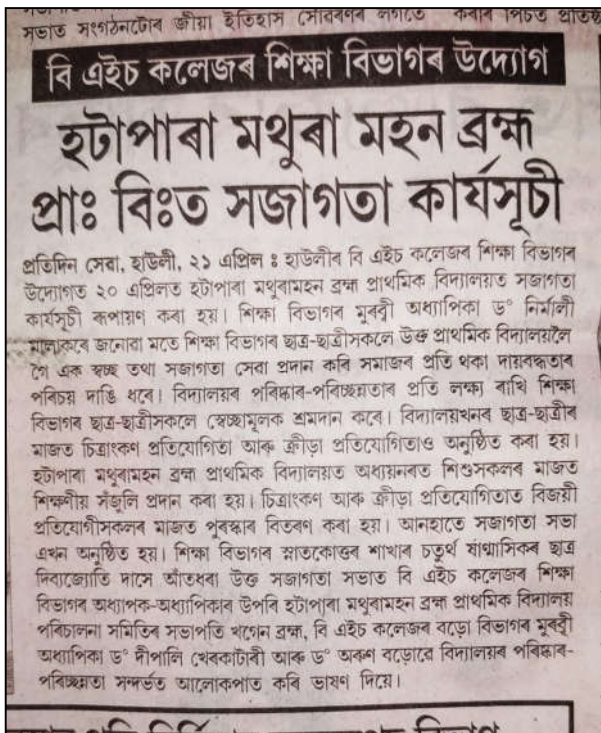
Name of the activity : Blood Donation Camp

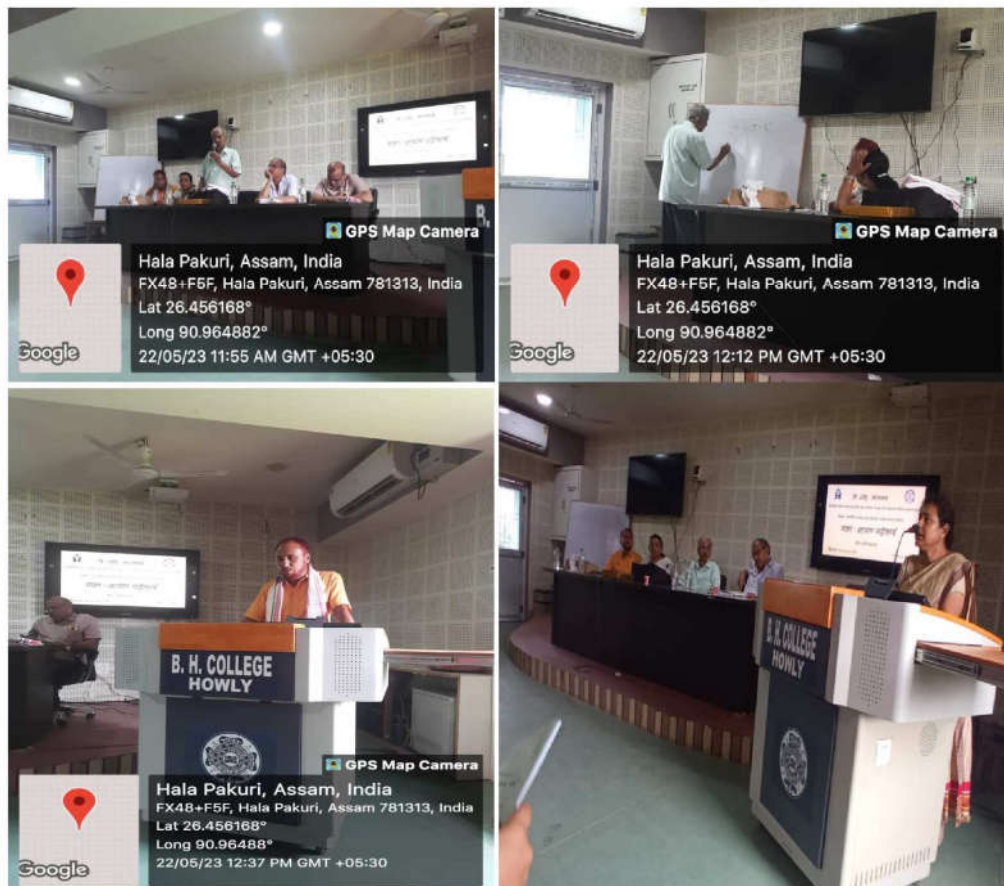
Name of the activity : Awareness meeting

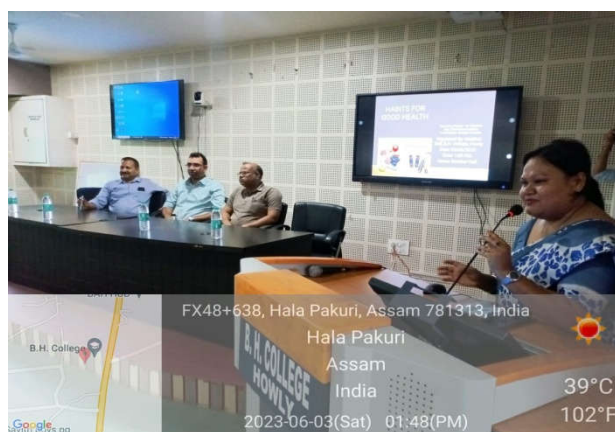
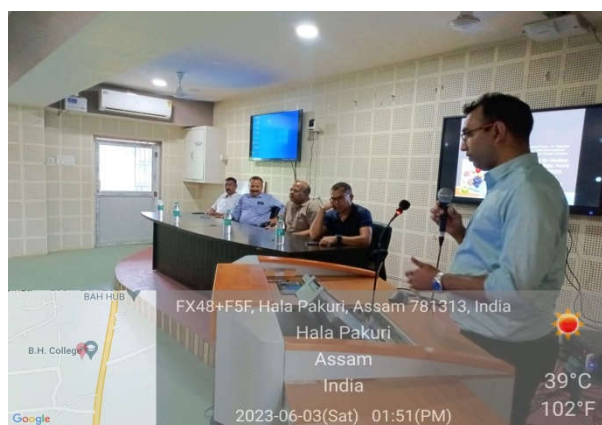
Name of the activity : Popular Talk

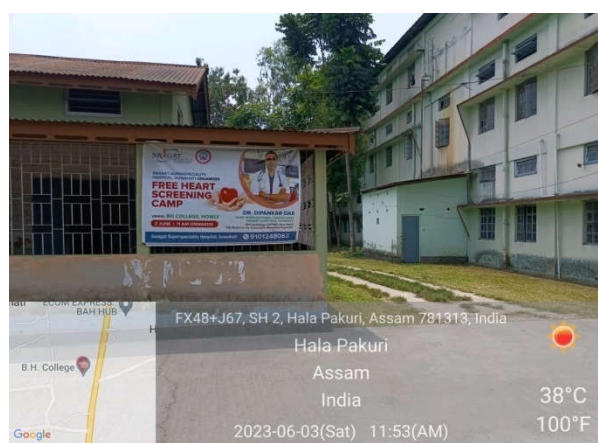
Name of the activity : Free Heart Screening Camp

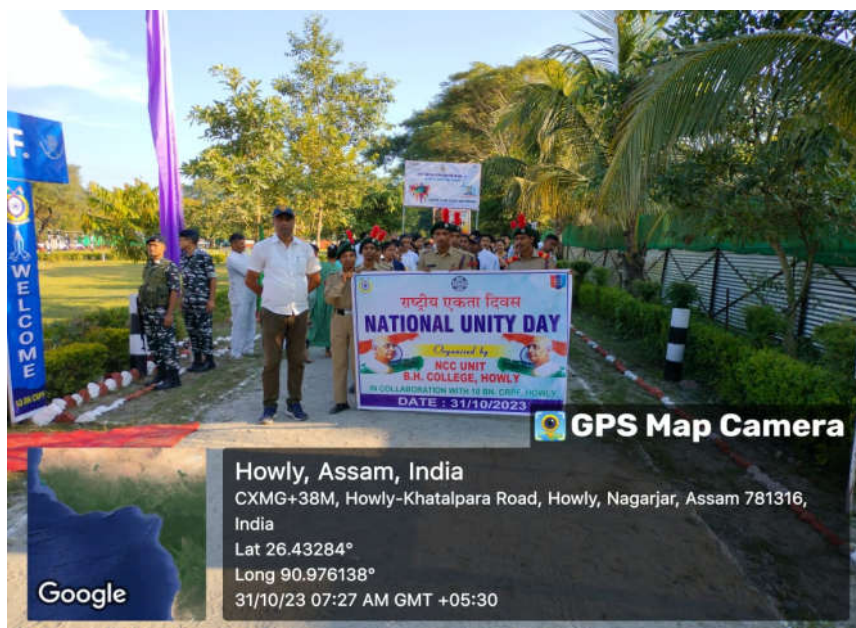

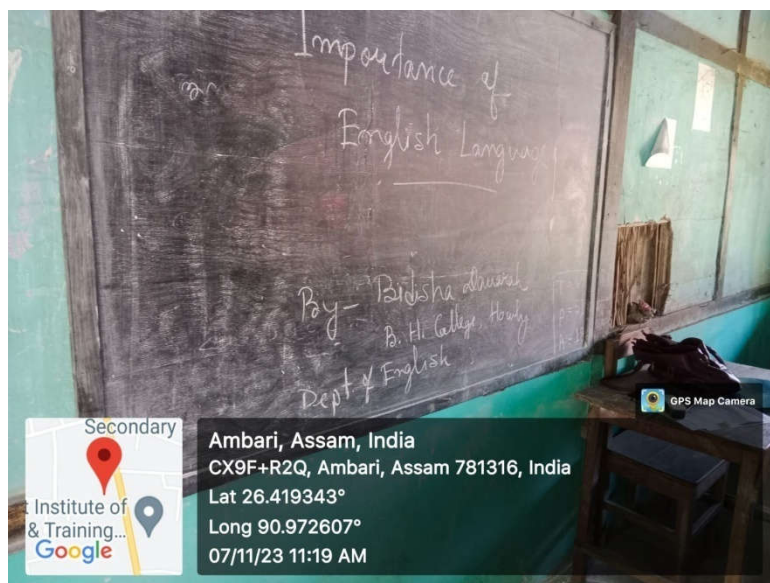
Name of the activity : ‘National Unity Day’ observation

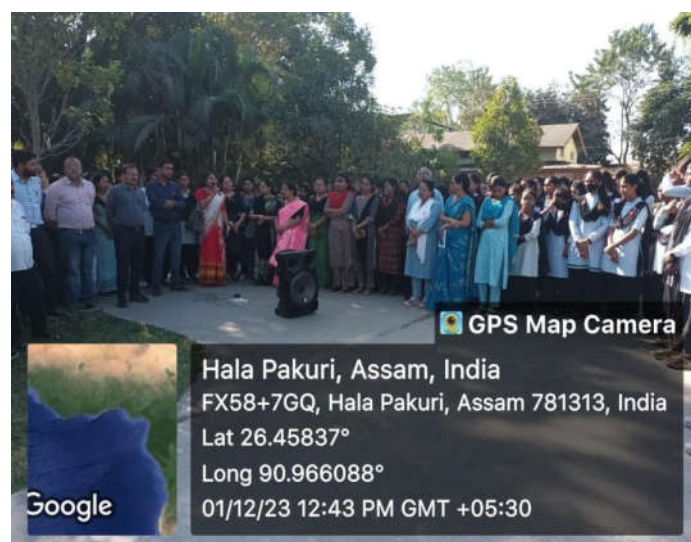
Name of the activity : 'Awareness and Prevention Programme on AIDS'
